But some seeds fell in good soil and sprouted; the plants grew and bore grain; some had thirty grains, others sixty and still others one hundred".

When Jesus was alone, some of those who had heard him came to him and asked him to explain the parable. "You have been given the secret of God", he replied, "but there are others who hear all things by means of parables so that they might turn to God and He may forgive them."

“Haven’t you understood this parable?” he asked. “Then listen! The sower sows God’s message. Sometimes it falls along the path; these people hear it but soon Satan comes and takes away the message sown in them. Other people are like the seed sown on rocky ground. When they hear the message they receive it gladly but it doesn’t sink into them and is destroyed. So when trouble or persecution comes to them, they give up at once. Other people are like the seed sown among the thorns. These are the ones who hear the message but their worries, their love for riches and many kinds of desires crowd in and choke the message and they don’t bear fruit. However, there are some who hear the message, accept it and bear fruit; some thirty; some sixty and some one hundred. They are like.....soil”.
